### What is the Bible?

#### • Hebrews 4:12

- "For the word of God is <u>living</u> and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart."
- Like a living, breathing person
- No matter how many degrees in scripture and language, you won't understand anything unless you are in a contact with Christ

- "My people are <u>destroyed for lack of knowledge</u>. Because you have rejected knowledge, I also will reject you from being priest for Me;"
- 2 Peter 1:5 Tower of virtues
- "But also for this very reason, giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue, to virtue <u>knowledge</u>"

## Why the Bible?

### • John 17:3

 "And this is eternal life, that they may <u>know You</u>, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent"

• We can't love someone unless we <u>know</u> them

• The more <u>time</u> you spend with the Bible, the better you get to know & love God

- You must pass through the wilderness from the first Adam to reach the second Adam

### How to read the Bible

- WHOLE
- The Bible is <u>one</u> book with <u>one</u> message
- The only way to understand it is to read it <u>all</u>
- Revelation 1:3
- "<u>Blessed is he who reads</u> and those who hear the words of this prophecy, and <u>keep those things</u> which are written in it; for <u>the time is near</u>"
- Nothing good can come if your Bible is closed



### How to live the Bible

- What is our biggest desire? The pursuit of...Jeremiah 15:16
- "Your words were found, and I ate them, And Your word was to me the joy and rejoicing of my heart;"
- "The Bible which is falling apart usually belongs to someone who isn't"
- Find, eat and chew!

## How to live the Bible

- Matthew 13:9 The Parable of the Sower
- Four different soils why was the seed spread to good soil and other soils? Why is there bad soil?
- 1 I need to <u>RECEIVE</u> the Word of God i.e. READ
- ② <u>HIDE</u> it in your heart "I have hidden your word in my heart so that I would not sin against you" Psalm 119:11
- ③ <u>TASTE</u> it "I Have found your words like honey and I ate it" – Psalm 119:103
- **(4)** <u>ACT</u> on it "Your word is a lamp unto my feet"-Ps119:105

### How to live the Bible

• How do we read the Bible in the Church?

- The Word of God is not just knowledge is Christ - so reading it is in fact <u>meeting</u> <u>Christ</u>.
- Receive, hide, taste and act on the Word of God → you will be fruitful & it will change your life!
