

What happened on HOLY THURSDAY

When it was the first day of unleavened bread, this was the day for the Passover lambs had to be scarified. Jesus ordered two of his disciples to go and prepare the Passover meal so that he can eat it with them. Usually that day is the fourteenth of Nissan when the Jews *stop* working by noon and get rid of any leavened bread from their houses.

Between noon and sunset they slaughter the Passover lamb

The Lamb slaughtered must be

- Perfect without blemish
- Blood Sprinkled on the door posts.
- Roast the whole lamb
- over a fire with its head legs and organs.
- Nothing left over until morning
- They must eat it with better herbs

and bread



Jesus is the Lamb of God slain as a sacrifice and substitute for our sins. (John 1:29)
